



USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by the Local Rules

**Local Rules:**

1. **Lateral Water Hazards:** Are designated by red stakes or lines.
2. **Water Hazards:** Are designated by yellow stakes or lines.
3. **Out of Bounds:** Are defined by white stakes, private property and public roads.
4. **Obstructions:** Pump house and its surrounding shrubbery on holes #10 (left, near lake). Cement drainage ditches not marked as hazards, the maintenance building and its surrounding shrubbery (left of #7 tee) are to be played as immovable obstructions. (Rule 24-2)
5. **Ground under Repair:** Are defined by white lines or roped off areas.
6. **Play from Flowerbeds:** Is prohibited. Relief must be taken as described in Rule 25-1.
7. **Cart Paths and Roads:** Relief is allowed when your stance or swing is interfered with by paved or unpaved paths and/or roads. (Worn areas next to paths are considered to be extensions of the path within a club length).
8. **Bridges:** All bridges which cross over hazards are integral parts of the hazard.
