

PETITION TO OPPOSE THE SAN VICENTE ROAD RELOCATION AND IMPROVEMENTS

At the request of San Diego Country Estates (SDCE), on October 23, 2012 a presentation was made by Steven Ron, Project Manager of the County Department of Public Works, and his 3 associates on the proposed relocation and straightening of San Vicente Road between Warnock and Wild Cat Canyon roads. The presentation was given to the SDCE Board and about 125 attending association members. It appeared that all in attendance were opposed to the project. The SDCE Board opposes the San Vicente Road Relocation and Improvements and requests the SDCE members to join in our opposition by signing this petition.

We the undersigned are opposed to the proposed San Vicente Road Relocation and Improvements and desire that it be retained in its present location for one or more of the following reasons:

- The proposed new road would not eliminate the major causes of accidents on the road: excessive speed, driving under the influence and inexperienced drivers
- The proposed road, with the same 50 MPH speed limit would only encourage people to drive faster, therefore less safe
- Horseback riders would not ride on a trail a few feet from 50+ MPH traffic
- The \$40,000,000 plus cost of the project (\$10 million per mile) is excessive for the project and not wanted by the community it is to serve
- We like the rural tree lined nature of the present road
- The project would require the removal of 145 native California Live Oak trees
- A bike lane could be added to the current road
